



It is in Saudi Arabia at the AL HUZAM stud farm that the Arab horses of Mr. ALHUZAMI are bred and trained. His name is already known in France through his recent acquisitions including MANAB the top price of St CLOUD and also for his success on the French racecourses with NAYAR ATHBAH. Mr. ALHUZAIMI kindly answered questions from AWA Magazine.





AWA: Can you give us a brief history of your beginnings in racing

Owning horses runs back many generations in the family. In my grandfather days their business in this regard extended from the middle to India. Nonetheless, we started breeding and owning racing horses in 2014. Our first winner was a 2016 crop filly in Saudi Arabia. Currently, we only own Arabian racing horses as well as Pure Saudi desert breed strains.

AWA: Who are your main performers, present and future

We have horses located in KSA, France, and UK. The current roster includes: NAYAR ATHBAH a winner in Saudi Arabia and France, SHALFA ALHEZAM a 2018 filly that placed twice, and MANABB as a 2019 prospect. We also have a group of 2020 promising colts and fillies: SINGASONG AL MAURY a colt by AL MOURTAJEZ & out of SALIA DE CARRERE daughter, BAIRAQ ALHEZAM a colt by ALAM AL KHALEDIAH & out of MORGANE DE PIBOUL daughter, as well as SHARFA ALHEZAM a filly by AAWAJ AL KHALEDIAH & out of CR SAMBORSTA dam line. We had horses in training with Mrs. Elisabeth Bernard in France as well as with Multiple trainers in Saudi Arabia Like Abdullah BHIAN, Omar ALTUWAILEE, Ali ALMEDFAA, Ibrahim AL MUHAIDEB, and Muqrin ALESSA.


AWA: What lines are the basics of your breeding

We own horses from multiple racing bloodlines like NEVADOUR, MANDORE, MORGANE DE PIBOUL, CR SAMBORSTA, BALLADORE, & CIDA. In addition we have Saudi desert bred strains of the HAMDANI and SUWAITY strains that we hope We had winners in France in 2019 and 2020, as well as a winner in Saudi Arabia this summer in Taif. Riyadh winter season starts very soon, and we have a participant that we hope in Gods willing to win.

AWA: What are your main objectives, in the short and long term

Gods willing, our mid-term goal is to hit the big global group races for Arabian horses in two to three years, and long-term goal is to have a breeding program that is competitive globally. As for 2022, we do anticipate to produce 7 horses.

AWA: What are your stallions choices

It would be very difficult to pin point, nonetheless, some of the stallions we used and focus on include MISTER GINOUX, JALNAR AL KHALEDIAH, MAHABB, ASSY, KHALID AL BWAIBIAH, AL MAMUN MONLAU, and AL MOURTAJEZ among others as well. We also are trying two prospect stallions that we have in stud ZAHIR ALKHALEDIAH & AF AMTHAL.

AWA : You have just acquired an excellent colt at the Arquia sale (MANABB) what were your selection criteria

Pedigree, confirmation, and multiple inspections. The colt family have been competitive for a long time and still does today. We saw that few days after the sale the world cup winner was produced by his maternal brother MISTER GINOUX and the second place is his maternal sister LADY PRINCESS.

AWA : You seem to be very attentive to maternal lines

Dam lines are assessed on their capability to produce high class horses as well as stability in producing winners, in this regard of course NEVADA II is one of the most prospers dam lines in the world.



2021 TOP PRICE OF THE SALE.

On September 30, the traditional sales of Arabian horses, racing and endurance took place in Saint CLOUD. The 2021 edition of this sale did not arouse the enthusiasm of participants, sellers as well as buyers. In addition to two horses, MANABB 2019 (MAHABB & NACREE AL MAURY) Breeder CHAMP GIGNOUX / E. BELLAUD sold € 230,000 and MOSHRIF 2018 (DAHESS & TASHREEFAT) breeder SHADWELL France sold € 185,000, many of the horses presented found a buyer for prices that the 'one can qualify as shy.

It should be noted that the first 6 horses sold, with the exception of MOSHRIF, are all descendants of NEVADOUR, a godsend for Haras du MAURY, the last owner of this extraordinary mare.

FALCONRY ON HORSEBACK

Powerful images of an ancestral practice, falconry on horseback in particular, bring together from time immemorial the relationships between the man and the Salukis dogs, the hawk and the horses – first and foremost with the purebred Arabian horse. They all depict situations full of burning passion for these three elements of such a dry region of the planet. Men have always been very impressed by the performance of raptors in the air and by the sharpness of their lines to the extent that many civilizations integrated them into their cultural heritage in all ways. Sheikh Zayed Al Nahyan, Founder of the United Arab Emirates, was the strongest supporter of this practice on horseback.

It is widely acknowledged that, in the countries of the Middle East, hawks have long been used during the war by their fierce and valiant horsemen. As well utilized to hunt the evening primrose, the houtarde or the gazelle of the desert, these powerful birds would be trained to attack the enemy's eyes, mainly the knights from the Crusades in that historical period so full of conquests. A belief still supported by locals, it is then the use of a lure and chaperone. Since then, all these techniques

have allowed for an increased use of the astonishing flying skills of the birds of prey.

To the same extent of the purebred Arabian horse - in a time of strong values and high principles - noble and powerful family crests became popular and many gyrfalcons and peregrine falcons served as important relational means between tribes or neighboring countries or valuable gifts that honored their owners.

The enthusiasm of passionate riders has always sprung from the natural world, from the discovery of large areas of freedom that provide unforgettable moments, and despite a long period of animal protection policy, concerning raptors in particular, there still is a growing interest in and pleasure for species that have been around us for centuries.

Especially as regards falconry, the awareness joint-campaigns promoted by many associations from Saudi Arabia, Belgium, Korea, the United Arab Emirates, Spain, France, Morocco, Mongolia, Qatar, Slovakia, Syria, have been rewarded in November 2010 with the recognition by UNESCO as 'World Intangible Heritage', an act of great importance motivated

by the need to preserve such 'in-flight hunting art' that has been recognized as one of the oldest in the history of human civilization.

To team up with these majestic sky hunters, the Arabian horse must be prepared. Ideally, on a first session, this can be initiated with a foal that will have to familiarize with the presence of a bird flying around him; the reactions from the colt will be instructive to envisage the most appropriate training program for him.

Skilled falconers will take position at the horse feet-level, on both sides of the animal at standstill and with no bridles so to avoid any stress effect. With them, they will carry a medium size bird such like, for instance, the Harris hawk buzzard (Parabuteo unicinctus) with which they will perform the callbacks rite from glove to glove.

When this practice is being strengthened, it can easily be repeated for about two months; the horse is then led with the halter, the glove is placed on his withers together with the bird while the fluttering of the feathers will no longer frighten him. There will follow a complementary training work with the ridden horse, and some part of the exercise being pretty much the same as the one practiced on foot: the flight of the bird





of a falconer who places himself on foot to the horse and his chevalier who, in turn, will always receive the bird on his left glove. This is pure tradition of Falconry, mastery is therefore important in order to make it progress also by considering the

This delicate exercise must be repeated at least for three weeks to test the docility of the horse. It is important to have a purebred Arabian full of energy, not to mention that he must work at ease for his necessary muscular gymnastics and his moral fiber.

In line with this evolutionary principle to abide by, the size of

When catching or capturing a prey, the falcon must remain
on the spot and within the hunting territory; the expert
falconer chooses his favorite bird and, often, in relation with
the lower flight, he will certainly choose an Eastern Chanting
Goshawk (Melierax poliopterus) or a Golden Eagle (Haliaeetus

leucocephalus), whereas in the higher flight, he can use either a Peregrine Falcon (Falco peregrinus) or a Gyrfalcon (Falco rusticolus) as well as the Saker Falcon (Falco cherrug) and the Eastern countries. Many reports have been drafted about the Asian regions with particular reference to Mongolia where wolf and fox hunting are still practiced with the use of Golden Eagles.

Yet, they also represent an opportunity for leisure activities at major local festivals.

On the contrast, in today's Middle East countries where falconry





is practiced in all comfort inside of all-terrain vehicles it is truly heartbreaking to note that - despite being an activity deeply rooted into the genes of local population - those same countries possessing the majority of the most beautiful Arabian horses of the world do not actually use them in what it could turn up to be an entertaining sport close to their culture and suitable to sandy grounds.

In almost all countries of the Arabian Gulf area, however, many events or in-flight hunting competitions are organized every year, but, unfortunately, the participant horses are not enough or even absent from the program.

In the huge region of Maghreb, a country with centuries-old traditions, in the Kingdom of Morocco, and more precisely in El Jadida, inhabitants still maintain the practice of falconry on horseback. Every year in August the great Moussem of this province gathers no less than a thousand riders, a well-known event in the world as its fervor and spectacle are simply great. However, horseback falconry, which is accessible to all adult riders, has its own codes and international and national authorities are in charge of securing compliance with a thousand-year-old tradition. Everyone must know that all birds have a registration; each must also be holder of a registration number within facilities specialized into the activity and respect the molting period of the birds ranging from mid-spring to the end of August.

Good equipment suitable for falconry on horseback is also needed; first of all, in supporting the hawks, the 'koubbile' chaperon is a cache that shall always be placed gently on the head of the bird so that it can remain in a calm environment.

It must be made of soft leather material to equip the head of the hawk gently, so you don't suffocate or damage its plumage.

The rider will wear on his left arm the glove named 'saâba' made of very thick leather that covers large part of his forearm, thus avoiding too much contact with the extremely powerful and sharp talons of the raptor; during horse hunting this hand serves as a perch.

The lure called 'jiaba' is a fake prey often made with ordinary birds wings that has a cavity in which a small amount of meat is put. This tool of the falconer rider is very useful during the sessions of falconry, especially to call back the hawk when it is in full flight.



The falconer -rider will always make sure to maintain the confidence of his bird, paying attention to his equipment, his laces 'sbouks', his hunting bag 'mezoued' containing all the stuff the rider - falconer finds it useful.

In Europe and in the World there exist 'Animal Parks' with more or less interest in what one could sometimes define as falconry areas for an understanding of this art, where competent professionals get themselves organized by creating spaces for presentations intended to value the full potential of birds within a certain educational function.

Among these top-quality establishments in Europe, given the great diversity of the species presented, Master-falconer Mr. Bernard Bailly established at the Amnéville Zoo in Lorraine a beautiful demonstration space which is a perfect example of this activity that comes along with beautiful paintings on traditional falconry on horseback.

Unfortunately, every year, mainly in Europe, several equestrian shows are put up with insufficient information thus creating inaccurate performances on the subject of falconry on horseback; many of them are more or less successful though they still manage to attract many curious.

We must be proud of the very good combination of the Arabian horse with falconry. Passionate riders are more numerous in what it is a very great sport in its own right, as well an unlimited natural pleasure that remains more than ever an art. Rider - trainer - falconer Mr. Hassen Bouchakour who was trained by great masters of the discipline, offers presentations that are worthy of this tradition.

Since ancient times, this immense art has been represented in important pictorial and sculptural works to which the greatest masters and world artists have devoted themselves also assisted by high-quality animal photographers.




In these spots once considered rest areas for caravans on the trans-Sahara trade road, the horses found the necessary rest while the men exchanged information and spread the news.

THE WILL OF A MONARCH

The late His Majesty King Hassan II, whose reign lasted thirty-eight years, used to be a fervent horse lover, riding every day near the Golf of Dar As-Salam. He nurtured a real passion for the pure-bred Arabian horse, shared with his brother, H.R.H Prince Moulay Abdallah, who owned the small, but beautiful farm located in Aïn El Aouda on the road to Zaer not far from Rabat.

Sel Having taken up the charge of Private Adviser to Prince Moulay Abdallah, I had the privilege, especially the chance to admire a magnificent stallion stationed there, the precious El Sud El Aaaly, chestnut stallion born in Egypt 1957 by Nazeer (Mansour x Bint Samiha) and out of Lateefa (Gamil III x Salwa) offered by Egypt to H-M King Hassan II. Later, I also discovered Haroun grey 1969 by Burhan and out of Kareman, Seef el Arab grey stallion born in Egypt 1974 by Kayed and ferial, Gawad chesnut stallion born in Egypt 1974 by Aseel and Rihana, these were all precious bloodlines that, however, would not get bred to increase the royal herd. A pity indeed because there exist only a few living specimens.

At the Royal Guard, in Rabat, while I was practising horse riding, I could find another hidden genetic treasure, the grey stallion Burhan born in Egypt in 1961 by Morafic (Nazeer x Mabrouka) and out of the mare Mouna (Sid Abouhom x Moniet El Nefous).

So, I informed Prince Moulay Abdallah about such genetic richness for the

Kingdom, and I respectfully urged him to join in the concert of nations linked to the Arabian horse industry.

When pressed, the Prince decided that it was time to take action. Therefore, he recommended establishing a development project, it followed the participation of Morocco at the Salon du Cheval in Paris in 1976, under the leadership of


the late H.R.H Princess Lalla Ami-

na, an extremely generous character whose success stay etched in the memories of many people for her tenacious and dynamic commitment to the breed.

At that time, the country took gigantic steps in the development and protection of the Arabian horse. The late Majesty King Hassan II

ordered to build the Royal Stud near Bouznika since he found the one in Douïet too small. It is an impressive building in the purest style, built at record time by thousands of workers who strove for the perfection of the property. It is considered one of the most beautiful in the world, bringing together Arab-Barb and original Barb horses, and led by Dr – Vet Lahcen Fdail.

Since then, the number of pure-bred Arabian horses has been controlled or even restricted, a decision that is hardly ever shared by most stud farms owned by private breeders or establishments across the world, outstanding reproducers get housed to keep up a quality not found anywhere else.


The most famous stallion from the Royal Stud of Bouznika is the dark bay Imperial Mashaar born in 1992 by Imperial Madheen and out of the mare Imperial Janaabah, unanimously crowned Paris World Champion in 1993, his highly sought-after offspring stay at the stud.

Before then, other stunning stallions had found in the Royal Stud a great shelter, for instance, the chestnut G.G Malachite chesnut born in the USA in 1982 by An Malik and El Nahr Falicia, and the chestnut Imperial Im Tarib born in the USA in 1982 by Ansata Imperial and out of Imperial Ti Amo, there, also imported mares got comfortably sheltered like the chestnut female Huda,



born in Jordan in 1975 by Bahrain and out of Haala, and the grey female The Other Woman born in the USA in 1982 by Tr Magnum and out of Cat Beau Lu.

The stud has also made significant acquisitions to ensure as much as necessary large reserves of new blood and the reinforcement of the herd with a qualitative vision of future development, it is managed by a highly qualified expert, supported by an exceptional team, highly competent and skilful enough to look after and preserve these precious horses which are from time to time presented in regional competitions, enabling the amateurs of the breed to observe by close the quality of the products that get bred in this exceptional geographic area.

In the spirit of favouring relationships among important breeders across the world, in the diaspora linked to the Arabian breed, I respectfully addressed to His Majesty King Hassan II in Palace Office of Rabat a solicitude to consider participation in the Salon du Cheval in Paris in 1976, an acceptance greeted by all for what was going to be an immeasurable success to the extent that Majesty King Hassan II decided to commit himself to grant his High Sponsorship to the creation in 1980 of the World Championship of the Arabian Horse support that I was personally given and maintained for many years.

The late H.R.H Princess Lalla Amina, who

held a special place in the hearts of all Moroccans, represented the link between the late H-M King Mohammed V, with whom she lived in exile in Madagascar.

Her commitments to underprivileged children have long been her great concern, in 1999, she took the Presidency of the Royal Moroccan Federation of Equestrian Sports, setting up a development program of breeding activities and equestrian sports requiring a change in the modern era in the direction of young people.

Spodex, the organizer of the 1976 Salon du Cheval in Paris, benefited from her immense involvement aimed at success, a Moroccan team from Jumping participated brilliantly in this event; tireless in the promotion of the horse in Morocco, in the valuation of the Tbouri-

THE PUREBRED ARABIAN HORSES BREEDING

The power of a country of Arabian horses' breeders and equestrian cultures with its millenary traditions, the Moroccan population lives in connection with nature that remains the soul of a nation through the Love and Respect for the human being's most noble conquest of what it would be his best companion and friend in life.

History tells us that many Oriental stallions got stationed in the depots of the Moroccan national stud farms in 1913, in the same year, the Meknes depot that had good pastures welcomed the stallion **Derouich**, born in 1916 by Karouf and out of Nabbu, which marked the creation of the Oujda and El Jadida depots that will change direction in 1946.

The creation of the Jumenterie de Meknes da-

tes back to the early days of the French protectorate, located near an old Makhzen fort its current action spreads over several regions focused mainly on purebred Arabian horses and Arabian- Barbe horses breeding.

Sprawling over sixty hectares nestled inside the Ismaili ramparts, the Jumenterie retained its prestigious reputation, at the time, famous stallions made their foundation exactly there, only to mention a few: Ordizan born in France 1937 by Abel and out of Danae; Shariar born in Egypt 1938; Minos by Dahmane and out of Mélissa by Pompadour; Quernin born in France in 1947 by Fellous and out of Jelala 1947; Agrès born in France in 1957 by Sumeyr and out of Altise by Abel gave exceptional products including Salam, a chestnut stallion born in 1969 by Agrès and out of Tosca; Dalia, a chestnut female born in 1974 by Agrès and out of Primerose; Nouria a chestnut female by Agrès and out of Endive; last but not least Ouergha, a chestnut female born in 1965 by Agrès and out of Endive.







Horses belonging to the Royal Stud like Kareman born in Egypt 1962 by El Sareii and out of Lateefa, Al Moraima born in Spain 1965 by Zafiro and out of Nubia II and Primrose 1966 by Burhan and out of Tosca, were all hosted there before being later gathered at the Royal Stud of Bouznika.

More particularly, Dalia 1974 by Agrés (Sumeyr x Altise), and Primerose (Burhan x Tosca) who got crowned Champion in the female category alongside the stallion Salam 1969 by Agrès (Sumeyr x Altise) and out of Tosca (Fellous x Allure) who obtained the Champion title, in 1985, they both participated in the International Arabian Horse Show in Marseille; the stallion also classified Vice-Champion at the Cannes International Arabian Horse

Show 1987, two pioneering events in the south of France organized by Spodex and the Agence Française du Cheval Arabe.

For some old Moroccan breeders who have a strong opinion on the recent development of the herd, the Arabian horse should not only be a show animal in specific breeding competition. We should bear in mind that he is first an athletic animal successfully employed for his extraordinary performan-

ces on racetracks.

The creation of the Moroccan Breeders Association aimed at the development of the breed for the country's welfare, with a breeding activity oriented towards a production responding to its traditions positioned between Europe and the African continent.

In the current context, Morocco is becoming a country model for many actors in the sector, rich in experiences and developments, effective ingredients that make it stand as a modern nation in terms of breeding, and, which above all things, takes into account Animal Welfare and its Protection more than elsewhere in the world.

BREEDING DEVELOPMENT

Not so long ago, there existed the Royal Society of Encouragement of the horse led by a great equine connoisseur, Dr Soussène Yacoubi he had undertaken a courageous promotional policy for the breed by employing new executives and experts in genetics in cooperation with his counterparts Colonel-Major Omar Daoudi and the then Director of the National

For the record, the first regulatory texts of the genealogical books of Morocco date back to 1948. William Richardot de Choisey worked on it upon request of the Office of the Royal Palace, intending to organize the global presentation of the Moroccan Stud Book - in collaboration with Minister Safah M'Zily of the Ministère de l'Agriculuture et de la Réforme Agraire in Rabat - as recognized by the World



In terms of breeding infrastructure, the activity is carried on through the divisions of the breeding stations of the various regional stud farms, controlled by a Central Administration; then, the National Artificial Insemination Center installed in Bouznika and approved by the European Commission in 2002.

The depots of the Moroccan national stud far-

ms, Oujda regional stud farm, Meknès regional stud farm, Bouznika regional stud farm, Al Jadida regional stud farm and Marrakech regional stud farm management to ensure the parents control very successfully, with certified identification and the national standards set according to precise criteria of improvement for the national production.

The private stallions are mostly reproducers for the breed, the workforce in progress, they must get annual approval, take morphological and health and blood grouping tests, aware of the importance of its equine heritage well-being, Morocco is taking action to develop its breeding and is determined to integrate the world elite of the sector, for a breeding program so ambitious in the current framework, importance is attached to the importations of firstclass broodmares, old strains, however, have not been rescued.



ACTORS IN THE BREEDING

A High Specialist: Doctor-Veterinarian Malak Benamar

In the history of a country concerned with the future of its breeding, it is imperative to count on



highly qualified stakeholders in relevant positions who often have a realistic breeding vision. Dr -Vet Malak Benamar is very valuable on this precise subject.

She made her studies at a time when access to women was not as open as today. In 1967, she completed her PhD successfully, presenting a dissertation on the "Evaluation of Equine Reproduction / Clinical and Bacteriological Investigations" and got

her first job at the national stud farms but, over the years, misunderstandings have not been lacking. However, given her undeniable knowledge in equine medicine, she deservedly accepted the post of Director of a stud, which is an establishment requiring a commitment at all times with little time to relax.

For the record, the stud farm for which Malak Be-



namar is responsible sprawls over eight hectares and became operational in 1994, the first national competition took place there, with the first appearance of Mohammed Machmoum, who later became an international judge.

Strongly involved in the development of the Arabian horse and well-known for her personal and uncompromising commitment to the protection of the horse, Malak Benamar takes part in the Disciplinary Commissions at many international competitions. We dare to think out loud that the worth of her person should no longer confuse her in this kind of position.

It is reassuring to note that in Morocco, people of this calibre have the priority to defend their living heritage still so present in their hearts and that women have relevant positions to take up in the development of the equine industry.

THE ARABIAN HORSE SHOWS

The Moroccan Breeders Association and its Show Commission establish Qualifying Regional Competitions every year to contend in a National Breeders Cup followed by the National Championship at the end of the season.

Belown shown the total number of horses participating in the regionals for the past ten years: 2010 = 267 horses / 2011 = 179 horses / 2012 = 263 horses / 2013 = 341 horses

2014 = 243 horses / 2015 = 204 horses / 2016 = 315 horses / 2017 = 216 horses

2018 = 317 horses / 2019 = 406 horses / 2020 = 389 horses / 2021 = 443 horses

total participation in 2021 = 269 females & 174 males.

these data show the development of the herd; the quality is in clear progression but, the internal market is not very active, with the Regional d'El Jadida registering the highest number of participants, September 11th and 12th, 2021, the National Breeders Cup in Meknes, finally on September 25th and 2th 6, 2021 the National Championship in El Jadida in a period with bearable weather conditions.

There is one competition per region for the year that can qualify to access the National Championship, a superior number of 'B' category competitions for the many horses not qualified for the 'A' would enable all insiders to meet again.

The most relevant Arabian Horse breeding farms in Morocco include El Aaz Arabians, Al Boraq Stud, Issan Stud, Menara Stud, Mohammedia Stud Farm, Ranch Adarouch Stud, Sel-



man Arabians, Shahada Stud, all having too few possibilities to take their horses to international competitions.

The success of the new Breeders' Cup created in 2011 and reserved for national breeders proves that in this country, the breeders still enjoy a special place in the facilities of the Salon du Cheval d'El Jadida, a competition with a modern character that made its appearance in the breeding sector in 2008.

These local gatherings have had successes of all kinds, we must pay tribute to two ancient handlers like Foutouh Abdesselam and Chahid Abdelkader, which despite their age in the speciality, are the pride and honour of Morocco because they opened the way to some promising young people, for example, Youssef El Mastour and Anas Aït Faraji also Hassan Kesseb.

There as anywhere else, it is necessary to rely upon a body of expert judges to guide the breeders and owners in the direction of the quality to promote a valuable herd, which will be the benchmark for national production.

I cannot name all the connoisseurs of the breed, however, I would like to mention Dr-Vet Mohammed Oussidhoum - International Judge and Dr Vet Mohamed Yaraaf-National Judge, two outstanding zootechnicians involved in the sector for a few years, they both enjoy

the esteem of participants in competitions, whether at regional or national levels, often invited during internationals, two prominent referents for Morocco.

We should not forget all those actors who can immortalize so well the best moments of the equestrian events in Morocco so that they can stay etched in our minds forever. In this respect, the talent of the photographer Driss Ben Malek is quite precious.

Any horse intended for National or International Arabian Horse Show must go through appropriate training according to its age, but grooming is what comes first to prepare any equine at the show appearance, in Morocco, the climate is mild throughout the year in all provinces, so the thing is pretty affordable.

During the competitions taking place in Morocco, a small number of handlers strive to do very well with their horses and lead them to victories, two of them, in particular, got noticed for their impeccable conduct

and considerable respect for the rules of handling.

To begin with, the young Youssef El Mastour, present in the arenas for a few years already, with the heavy responsibility of presenting the Arabian horses from the Royal Stud of Bouznika, a very professional activity that he performs with seriousness and pleasant skills to follow, so great victories will boost his career.

As the value of an individual can't only depend on age, the very young Anas Aït Faraji representing Mohammedia Arabian Farm is still very determined despite the too large number of horses to be presented at each competition, a too intense physical investment not always rewarded by the rankings obtained despite horses ready to compete in excellent conditions. 


